

4/26/2010 LOTHAC meeting minutes:

This is not to be construed as prohibiting the members of LOTHAC from any participation or support of these functions, but to sever any legal responsibility that could be inferred from LOTHAC's participation.

Gunars Cakste has repeatedly shown a desire to take differing directions from that of what LOTHAC has taken. So as not to discourage any avenues of spreading the Gospel of Christ, he would be completely free to go in the direction he is being led. He would not be bound by hindrances from the direction LOTHAC has been led, therefore maximizing the effects of each ministry.
